OSOC Assessment

Effective on January 1, 2020, Ohio Administrative Code section 5123-9-30 (F)(11) includes a reference to the use of “a department-approved tool” to assess and document the determination of the appropriateness of On-Site/On-Call (OSOC) services for a person with developmental disabilities.

DODD has created an electronic version of the tool in an effort to facilitate the process and make information more readily available. As of January 10th, the electronic version of the OSOC tool is available in the Assessment Center housed in DODD’s portal for county boards to utilize during the service planning process. SSAs over the next couple of months will be completing them for people who are currently using or that are being considered for OSOC services. This tool will also be completed for people authorized for awake staff to determine if OSOC is appropriate. After this initial entry period, the form will be completed during the typical PCP planning period.
